

Academic Excellence

- Has students taking Algebra, Geometry, Algebra 2, Spanish, and/or French for high school credit.
- Has a renowned Peer Tutoring program that has served a model for other area school districts.
- Has been awarded Governor's Thomas Edison Award for Excellence in STEM Education for the 21 consecutive years.
- Has been honored as a Google Reference School for the exemplary work conducted using Google Apps for Education as a 1-1 technology building.
- Consistently earns an "A" in Value-Added for state of Ohio

• Every student takes a STEM course in the 6th and 8th grades with other STEM courses offered in all 3 grades.

Developmental Responsiveness

- Has an advisory period called EAGLE period that serves as model for area districts.
- Intense intervention program provided for every student in need
- A PBIS program is in place led by a student group called the Positivity Committee.
- Peer tutoring programs that provides tutors for all students in need.
- Friendship Club to provide social/emotional support for students with intensive needs.
- Multiple support groups organized by the guidance counselors for students in need of emotional support such as a Grief Group.

Social Equity

- Each student is provided a chromebook for 24/7 access.
- Every 8th grade student experiences Challenge Day with the Challenge Day--Be The Change organization.
- All 6th grade students attend a three day camp to build leadership and teamwork skills.
- All 8th grade students attend a two day camp to build leadership and teamwork skills.
- Provides many clubs and organizations based on student interest.
- Partnered with Safe Routes to Schools to add walkways to connect the school with area housing.

Organizational Support

- Has flexible scheduling for math classes so that teachers can regroup classes dependent upon student need.
- Grade level teams are in place.
- Teacher-Based Teams along with a Building Leadership Team in place.
- Traditional scheduling with block scheduling utilized for special events and situations.
